



ENAIRe posted its best-ever figures in 2025 with almost 2.5 million flights and the highest customer rating in perceived quality

- ENAIRe managed 4.7% more flights than in 2024, exceeding the European Union's average increase
- All control centres saw increased traffic, most notably Seville (+6.5%), Barcelona (+5.5%) and the Canary Islands (+4.8%)
- International flights exceeded 1.4 million (+5.6% compared with 2024); overflights grew by 6.2% and domestic flights by 0.4%
- In 2025, ENAIRe achieved a perceived quality level of 81.1%, the highest in its historical series for the third consecutive year

ENAIRe, the Spanish air navigation service provider, once again broke the record for flights managed in 2025, building on 2024, which was already a record year. This is the highest number of flights ever managed: nearly 2.5 million (2,470,604), almost 5% (4.7%) more than in 2024.

Compared with 2019 levels, before the pandemic, the annual increase is 14.9%.

Furthermore, in 2025, the increase in flights managed in Spain over 2024 exceeded the European average by 0.7 percentage points (which stands at 4.0%) and by 14.8 points compared with 2019 (in Europe, it was 0.1%).

In 2025, there were 1,431,277 international flights (+5.6% compared with 2024); 571,017 (+6.2%) overflights, which do not land at or depart from a Spanish airport, and 468,310 domestic flights (+0.4%).

All ENAIRe control centres saw significantly increased traffic in 2025 compared to 2024: Seville, 6.5% (572,305 flights in total); Barcelona, 5.5%

Note. The total traffic registered by ENAIRe's network does not correspond to the sum of flights managed by each control centre (CC). This is because each CC records a flight depending on the route and airspace it crosses, but that flight is only counted once in the ENAIRe network as a whole. For example: a flight departing from Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport bound for Josep Tarradellas Barcelona-El Prat will be registered in both the Madrid and Barcelona CC, but only once in the network.

December data

As for the last month of the year, the total number of flights was 182,727, 4.7% more than in 2024 and 22.8% more than in 2019. Of these, 100,628 were international (+5.5%), 45,927 overflights (+7.3%), and 36,172 domestic flights (-0.5%). All ENAIRe control centres saw increases in the number of flights managed in December: Barcelona, 78,382 flights (+7.0%); Seville, 46,360, (+7.0%); Madrid, 108,020, (+3.9%); Palma, 14,413, (+2.6%); and the Canary Islands, 39,680 (+1.1%).

Record in perceived quality as well

In 2025, ENAIRe achieved a customer-perceived quality level of 81.1%, the highest value in its historical series for the third consecutive year, surpassing the target set in its Strategic Plan (Flight Plan 2025) by 3.1 percentage points and closing the year with an accumulated increase of 11.6% since 2020.

About ENAIRe

ENAIRe is the air navigation service provider in Spain.

As a company of the Ministry of Sustainable Transport and Mobility, it provides air traffic control services during the en route and approach phases of all flights to and from Spain and overflights. In addition, it manages communications, navigation and surveillance services from ENAIRe in the airspace and the entire AENA airport network in Spain and provides aerodrome air traffic control services in 21 airports, including the busiest.

ENAIRe is the fourth largest European air navigation service provider, and it is a member of international partnerships A6 Alliance, SESAR (Single European Sky ATM Research) Joint Undertaking, SESAR Deployment Manager, iTEC, CANSO (Civil Air Navigation Services Organisation) and collaborates closely with ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization).

ENAIRe has obtained the highest rating in the key performance indicator for air safety at European scale for six consecutive years, the last five with the maximum possible score of 100%. It has also been awarded the EFQM 600 Seal for its safe, efficient, innovative and sustainable management of air navigation services.
