What workgroups are available?

CANSO's work is broadly divided into three programme areas; safety, operations and strategy and integration. The work in each of these areas is led and supported by a standing committee, that is responsible for overseeing and guiding the work of the programme and the working groups and task forces that fall under it and to establish new groups to address important issues as required.



Safety is the ATM industry's number one priority. The safety programme aims to continually improve safety performance in ATM operations; further enhance safety management and culture; and provide global leadership on safety management issues.

Strategy and Integration

Deals with policy and regulatory aspects of air navigation services and identifies and creates tools and guidance materials in all areas of ATM governance and management.
