### Objective:

The aim of the workshop is to introduce the CANSO Global Air Navigation Services Performance Report to ANSPs who are keen to join CANSO benchmarking activities. The CANSO Global Air Navigation Services Performance Report provides an annual global overview of air navigation service provider (ANSP) performance. It compares key financial and productivity indicators from participating ANSPs, highlighting global performance trends and identifying gaps. The report therefore provides a basis for collective improvement, enabling ANSPs and their stakeholders to make informed decisions when pursuing increased cost-effectiveness and productivity, without impacting safety.

Held concurrently with the GBWG/30 meeting, workshop participants will have the opportunity to share benchmarking experiences, applications, and related benefits with GBWG participants.
