
Operational Perspective

- <u>2020</u> Investment decisions related to people and technology must trade-off short and long-term goals.
- <u>2021 to 2025</u> Define the minimum set of capabilities we need in the operation in a potential Yo-Yo traffic return scenario.
- <u>2025 and Beyond</u> Actively identify the candidate capabilities for higher level automation and build a transition plan for the people and the technology.



Safety Perspective

- <u>2020</u> Ensure organisations safety capability is fit for purpose including remaining connected with operations; this will help understand the impact of changes on safety performance <u>now</u>.
- 2021 to 2025 Continue to review safety performance indicators inter-linked with operational performance; to understand long term impacts of change on safety performance.
- 2025 and Beyond Develop new safety methods that enable the introduction of higher-levels of automation, and remote services, matched with human performance capabilities.
