# **PBN NON-REGIONAL ROUTE**

- Establishment of PBN Nonregional (domestic) route:
  1. BTJ – CGK (2020)
  2. SRG – KOE (2021)
  - 3. SUB DJJ (2022)
  - 4. CGK MDC(2023).
- Shorter than existing conventional routes, and onedirection route.
- Potential new PBN route (1-3 above) per year:
  - Reduce CO<sub>2</sub> = 1,475 Tons
     Fuel saving = USD 1.4 M
- Connected to 30's airports by Instrument Flight Procedures (IFP) to achieve CCO/CDO flights.

Cluster 1 - 2020 Cluster 3 - 2022 Surabaya - Papua Aceh - Jakarta Cluster 4 - 2023 Cluster 2 - 2021 Semarang - Kupang Jakarta - Manado

## **ANS IMPROVEMENTS**

Service improvement by providing **surveillance in lower level airspace** (CTR-TMA) carried out by consolidating the approach control services 30 Approach Control Office (APP) locations, to be handled by 12 APP locations.

- Procedural to Surveillance Padang CTR-TMA, by Pekanbaru APP (2019\*);
- Procedural to Surveillance Pangkal Pinang CTR-TMA, by Palembang APP (2021);
- Procedural to Surveillance Bengkulu, Jambi, Tanjung Pandan CTR-TMA, by Palembang APP (2022);
- Procedural to Surveillance CTR-TMA in Papua area, by Jayapura APP (2023).

## **USER PREFERRED ROUTE**

- As discussed with IATA, AirNav Indonesia with assistance from DGCA Indonesia composed concept of operation, procedures and carry out safety assessment to implement UPR trial operation over Indonesia airspace.
- UPR will benefit airlines and act as a stimulus for traffic growth in the region

## **USER PREFERRED ROUTE**

- User Preferred Route (UPR) is based on FREE ROUTE concept where Airspace Users may freely plan a route between a defined entry point and a defined exit point with the possibility to route via intermediate way points without referring to the ATS route network.
- UPR allows the airlines to plan their flight through the most efficient route taking into consideration wind speed & direction, turbulence, temperature, aircraft type & performance.

### UPR Trial in Indonesia:

- Started in June 2020;
- Within JKT FIR & UPG FIR;
- From FL310 up to FL600;
- Overflying & International Flight;
- Avoiding the PRD area.

### Aeronautical Chart used for:

- Aircraft Navigation;
- Pilots;

## Disadvantages of Conventional Aeronautical Chart:

- Accessibility; only available in hardcopy, cannot be access as online.
- **Time;** take time deliver to customers, not real-time.
- **Cost**; require a high operational cost.
