1. Create a homogeneous geographical membership of CANSO by:

- Inviting Kyrgyzaeronavigatsia; Tajikairnavigation and Turkmenhowayollary to:
 - Attend CANSO Executive Summit and Airspace World in Geneva week 18 March 2024
 - Consider joining CANSO and regional community (AZANS; DHMI; Kazaeronavigatsia and Uzaeronavigation already being CANSO members) as a CANSO Member
- Establishing a CEO Committee dedicated to the region proposal for a dedicated follow up ANSP CEOs regional meeting in the fringes of the <u>CANSO Global ATM Summit and AGM</u> in Baku, week 11 June
- Shedule 2nd ANSP CEOs Regional Summit kindly offered to be hosted by DHMI in Q3/4 2024
- Develop a concept of operation for shared strategic goals proposal to organise a workshop by CANSO/Think Research in Q2 (Baku, after CANSO AGM, 14 June)
- Develop a concept for Regional CANSO ATFM Data Exchange Network workshop to be organised during Airspace World in Geneva week commencing 18 March with the proposal submitted in advance; ANSP will review if their legislation allows for data sharing
- Oragnise a webinar with an introduction to existing CANSO programmes such as ANSP Peer Review; Standard of Excellence in Air Navigation Safety (SEANS-Safety); Green ATM; etc.



- 2. Initiate regular meetings and communication channels between these Central Asia groups and Europe Forums to:
 - Ensure effective collaboration and information sharing
 - Joining CANSO Europe Members (AZANS and DHMI) at the next CANSO CEO Committee
 20 March in Geneva
- 3. Enhance the participation of Central Asia countries in regional and international aviation forums to:
 - Promote the exchange of views and experience with other aviation stakeholders
 - EASA forum on GPS interference
 - Visit to EUROCONTROL & NM
 - Create a Regional airspace user (airline) & ANSP forum to:
 - Facilitate discussion on Route Network Development and review safety improvements
 - Extend platform to neighbouring FIRs/CANSO Members from other regions



4. Create a Regional COO/Directors of Operations Forum to:

- Foster capacity-building initiatives in Central Asia, with a focus on Operations, ATM/CNS equipment, and human resource development/training
- Evolution of ATC training and licensing (e.g. use of radars in training, certification, etc) – invite Central Asia Members to join next Europe COO Forum in Brussels on 5 March

5. Establish a Regional Directors of Safety Forum to:

Facilitate discussions on enhancing safety management systems and sharing best practice

6. Establish a Regional Cybersecurity Forum to:

- Facilitate the sharing of best practice in addressing challenges in cybersecurity
- Invite Central Asia Members to join CANSO Europe Cybersecurity TF 6-7 March in Brussels



- 4. Over a period of time, create a Euro-Asia CANSO Region:
 - With a dedicated regional office or hosted/seconded by one of the ANSPs in the region
