




- Driving License

As of 01.01.2016, Turkish citizens can drive for 1 year and foreigners can drive for 6 months with a driver's license obtained from abroad. At the end of this period, our country's driver's license must be obtained.

- Emergency Numbers

8. Places that can be visited in İstanbul

DOLMABAHÇE PALACE

Dolmabahçe Palace located in the Beşiktaş district of Istanbul, on the European coast, served as the main administrative center of the Ottoman Empire from 1856 to 1887 and from 1909 to 1922.




GALATA TOWER

Considered among the oldest towers in the world and one of the symbols of İstanbul, Galata Tower (Galata Kulesi) was included in the UNESCO World Heritage Temporary List in 2013. Galata Tower, one of the most important structures that make up the silhouette of İstanbul, was used as a long-term fire watchtower and was named Galata Fire Tower.



TOPKAPI PALACE - OTTOMAN IMPERIAL PALACE

This palace served as the main residence and administrative headquarters of the Ottoman Sultans. Topkapı Palace (Topkapı Sarayı) and Harem are likely to have more colourful stories than most of the world's museums put together. Sultans lived and worked here between the 15th and 19th centuries when it was the court of the Ottoman empire. A visit to the palace's opulent pavilions, jewel-filled Treasury and sprawling Harem gives a fascinating glimpse into their lives.



9. PICK UP POINT
