



Over 170,000 flights

The number of flights managed by ENAIRE in November was 8.4% higher than in 2023, a record year

- International flights grew by 10.5%, domestic flights by 6.4% and overflights by 5.4% compared to the same month last year
- All ENAIRE control centres saw increases in the number of flights of more than 6%
- The growth of air traffic in Spain exceeded the European average by almost 4 percentage points in November, and 20 points compared to the same month in 2019
- So far this year, ENAIRE has handled nearly 2.2 million flights, 7.7% more than in the same period in 2023

ENAIRE, Spain's air navigation service provider, managed over 170,000 flights (171,828) in November, 8.4% more than in the same month in 2023, a record year.

International flights in November (94,870) were up by 10.5%, domestic flights (36,482) 6.4%, and overflights (40,476), which do not land at or depart from a Spanish airport, 5.4%.

This growth in air traffic in Spain in November exceeds by almost 4 percentage points (3.8%) the European average, which stands at 4.6%, and is 20 percentage points higher (19.9%) compared to the same month in 2019 (before the COVID pandemic), which was at -3.8%.

All ENAIRE control centres registered an increase in the number of flights managed of more than 6%: Palma recorded 15,458 flights (+13.5%); Seville, 42,652 (+11.0%); Canary Islands, 37,951 (+10.1%); Barcelona, 72,446 (+9.3%); and Madrid, 101,265 (+6.9%).

Note. The total traffic registered by ENAIRE's network does not correspond to the sum of flights managed by each control centre (CC). This is because each CC records a flight depending on the route and airspace it crosses, but that flight is only counted once in the ENAIRE network as a whole. For example: a flight departing from Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport bound for Josep Tarradellas Barcelona-El Prat will be registered in both the Madrid and Barcelona CC, but only once in the network.

Cumulative data for 2024

In the first eleven months of the year, ENAIRE managed nearly 2.2 million flights (2,184,432), 7.7% more than in the same period in 2023. International flights from January to November (1,259,581) rose by 9.6%, overflights (494,813) by 5.5% and domestic flights (430,038) by 4.9%.

This growth in air traffic in Spain so far this year exceeds the European average, which is 5.2%, by 2.5 percentage points, and is 13.1 percentage points higher compared to the same period in 2019, which was -3.9%.

The cumulative data for the year also show that all ENAIRE control centres registered an increase (of over 5%) in the number of flights managed: Canary Islands, 374,075, 8.8% more than in 2023; Barcelona, 1,045,253, 8.6% more; Seville, 494,004, 8.1% more; Madrid, 1,179,590, 7.1% more; and Palma, 357,274, 5.8% more.
